*How To Qualify:

- a. Less than 20 contestants = First place
- b. 20-34 contestants = First, Second, Third Place
- c. 35-50 contestants = Finals round bid*
- d. 51-70 contestants = Semifinals round bid*#
- e. 71+ contestants = Quarterfinals round bid*

*Rounds must be held to earn a bid at the appropriate level.

#Hosts may use the Champs/Honors final format in lieu of a semifinal.

For clarification: one duo = two contestants, so 18-25 duos provides a finals round bid.

Submitting Results:

In an effort to verify qualifiers, we request that you promptly submit results for NIETOC events (Drama, Humor, Duo, Duet, Oratory) in one of the following ways:

- 1) If you use the Joy of Tournaments software, you can simply email the (.jot) file.
- 2) If you use the Rich Edwards TRIEPC program, another tab program, or your own spreadsheets, those can be printed and scanned/emailed as attachments.

Regardless of the format, it is important that we are able to: (1) verify the number of participants in the event, (2) view all out-rounds, and (3) confirm final placings. We MUST have student and school names for all bid recipients.
